

sign the lyrics **A Heart Full of Music**

Sign the most important words.

heart: Use your index fingers to outline a heart shape on your chest.

full: Wipe open R hand over your L fist as if you were showing that a cup was full.

music: Wave R hand back and forth over L forearm.

song: Same as music. Or twirl R index finger starting from mouth and moving it away.

world: The right 'W' hand makes a complete circle around the left 'W' hand and comes to rest on the thumb edge of the left 'W' hand.

harmony: Hold both fists together and make one circle with them in front of your body.

where: Hold the R index finger up with palm out. Shake it back and forth from left to right.

I or I'm: Point to self.

belong: The tip of the R index finger, held in the 'D' position, palm facing left, is held at the lips, and the hand moves straight out and away from the lips.

one: Hold up R index finger.

gift: Both 'A' hands, with index fingers somewhat draped over the tips of the thumbs, are held palms facing in front of the chest. They are pivoted forward and down, in unison, from the wrist.

dreaming: The R curved index finger opens and closes quickly as it leaves its initial position on the forehead and moves up into the air.

love: Cross either the closed or flat hands over the heart with palms facing in.
