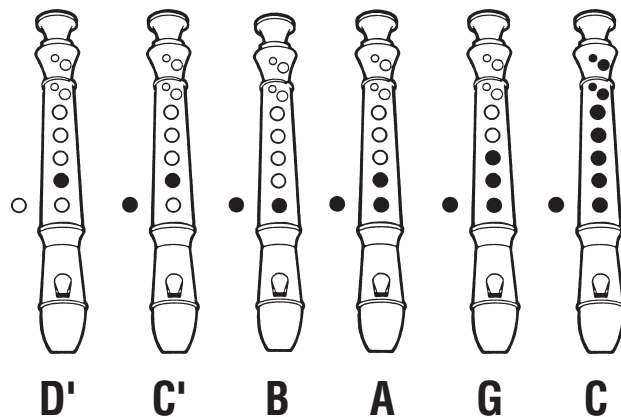

- Recorder fingerings for D', C', B, A, G, C
- $\frac{4}{4}$ time signature
- *p*, *mp*, *mf*, *f*
- accent
