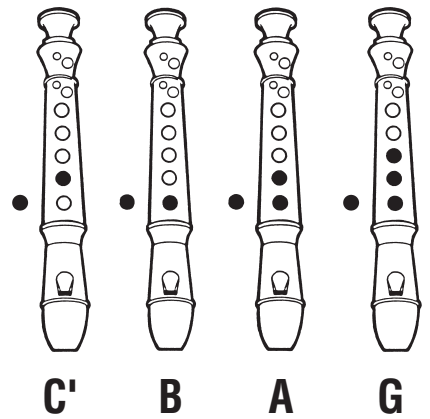

The Recorder Reporter says this is what you need to know to play "Jingle Bell Joyride":

- Recorder fingerings for C, B, A, G
- $\frac{4}{4}$ time signature
- *mf*

REPORTER'S SUGGESTION: Practice tonguing the eighth notes by moving your tongue to the back of your teeth while blowing a continuous stream of air. Play the eighth notes short and detached like jingle bells on a sleigh ride.
