

# YOUR MUSICAL JOURNEY

*May be used with the David Fanshawe feature, in the May/June 2005 issue.*

1. You are starting in **San Antonio, Texas** where you hear a concert of cowboys perform “The Yellow Rose of Texas” (*Find San Antonio on the map and place your pencil tip on the dot.*)
2. Next you go up north to **Minot, North Dakota** where we play in the marching band at the local air force base. (*Draw a line from San Antonio to Minot with your pencil.*)
3. Then you travel to **Minneapolis, Minnesota** to sit in on an orchestra rehearsal with the Minnesota Symphony. (*Draw a line from Minot to Minneapolis.*)
4. **Denver, Colorado** is your next stop–The Mile High City. You sing “The Colorado Trail” at a local shopping mall. (*Draw a line from Minneapolis to Denver.*)
5. Off you go to **Albuquerque, New Mexico** where you sing songs around a desert campfire. (*Draw a line from Denver to Albuquerque.*)
6. You then travel to **Dallas, Texas** and are honored to be part of the half-time entertainment at a Dallas Cowboys football game. (*Draw a line from Albuquerque to Dallas.*)
7. When you get to **St. Louis, Missouri**, you listen to a concert of jazz musicians playing near the great arch. (*Draw a line from Dallas to St. Louis.*)
8. Then in **Topeka, Kansas**, you sing your favorite song for the folks at a local corn festival. (*Draw a line from St. Louis to Topeka.*)
9. You end your musical journey in **Amarillo, Texas**, where you sing “The National Anthem” for elementary students just like you! (*Draw a line from Topeka to Amarillo.*)
10. Step back and take a look at your route. What musical shape do you see?
